Student Workshops

Content

- Building racial empathy and understanding
- Peer-led approaches to challenge casual racism & racist banter

Format

Whole school, single day delivery. x4 two hour sessions ran simultaneously (Y12&13 merged). Two facilitators (one facilitator per year group).

- 30 Min whole year assembly
- 45 Min form based activities
- 45 Min whole year interactive peer led workshop

Teacher Training

Content

- An introduction to anti-racism within the context of the UK
- The rationale for anti-racism within your school setting and organisational and individual responsibilities
- Acquiring vocabulary and confidence to talk about race
- Recognising and challenging incidents inside and outside of the classroom

Format

Whole school delivery over a half day inset. 2 facilitators delivering simultaneously.

- 45 Min whole school assembly
- 75 Min whole school interactive workshop with small group activities

Safeguarding Training

Content

- Culturally considered safeguarding within school and the local community

Format

Whole school or allocated staff on request. Delivered over a half day inset or a satellite session. 1 facilitator.

- 120 Min interactive session
